ABCS OF COMPUTER SCIENCE GLOSSARY



ALGORITHM

A set of instructions for accomplishing a task

BROWSER

Takes you anywhere on the internet

CPU

Central Processing Unit
Carries out instructions so a computer can operate

DATA

A collection of information

ENCRYPTION

The process of hiding information so it cannot be read without special knowledge

FIREWALL

A security system that monitors network traffic

GIGABYTE (GB)

A specific unit of measurement in computers and other electronics (A unit of data that's equal to about 1 billion bytes of data)

HACKER

A person who uses computer skills to overcome technical problems

INTERNET

A network that connects millions of computers worldwide

JAVA

A programming language used by Computer Scientists

KEY


A piece of information used to get some data

LIBRARY


A collection of reusable computer files to be used by programmers

MEMORY

Where the computer stores information for quick access

NETWORK

A set of computers sharing the same resources

OUTPUT DEVICE

A way to get information out of the computer

PROGRAM

An algorithm turned into code to be run by the computer

QUERY

A request for information

ROUTER

A box that passes information between computers

SOFTWARE

A set of instructions that tell a computer what to do

TRAFFIC

Traffic is data that is moving across the network

USER

A person who uses a computing device

VIRUS

Harmful software that spreads from one computer to another

WIFI

Wireless signal that connects devices to the internet

XML

A language that lets you make documents that both humans and computers can read

YOUTUBE

An online video-sharing and social media platform

ZIP

A way to put more than one file into a single place
